General Election

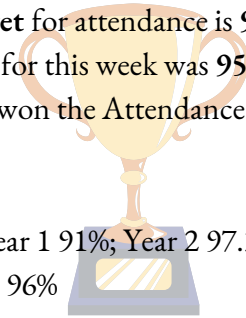
